
Rib Check Scarf





A straightforward knit for beginners using one set of needles. The check pattern at each end gives stylish, impressive results from simply using knit and purl stitches. This scarf is long as it's designed to be wrapped around.

Materials

Approx. 160g of DK Weight (2/5nm) Iona Wool

Needles

A pair of 7mm needles

Abbreviations

St(s) - Stitch(s)

RS - Right Side

WS - Wrong Side

K - Knit

P - Purl

Pattern

Cast on 30 sts

Row 1 (RS): (K1, P1) 15 times

Repeat row 1 seven more times

(8 rows total)

Row 9 (RS) knit

Row 10 (WS) p2, *k5, p2 repeat from * to end

Row 11 (RS) knit

Row 12 (WS) p2, *k5, p2 repeat from * to end

Row 13 (RS) knit

Row 14 (WS) p2, *k5, p2 repeat from * to end

Row 15 (RS) knit

Row 16 (WS) p2, *k12, p2; repeat from * to end

Row 17 (RS) k2, *p12, k2; rep from * to end

Row 18 purl

Row 19 knit

Row 20 p2, *k5, p2; repeat from * to end

Row 21 knit

Row 22 p2, *k5, p2; repeat from * to end

Row 23 knit

Row 24 p2, *k5, p2; repeat from * to end

Row 25 p7, *k2, p12, k2, p7

Row 26 k7, *p2, k12, p2, k7

Rows 9 to 26 form rib check pattern



Repeat rows 9 to 26 three more times

Next row knit

Next row Knit

Repeat the last 2 rows until scarf measures 190cm

Repeat Rows 9 to 26 four times

Repeat row 1 eight times

Cast off

Weave in ends neatly to finish

Gently wash and block dry

Washing and blocking
